

ACCOMODATION OPTIONS

There are a number of options available to you for accommodation.

PCYC— At the PCYC there are bunk rooms, plus a limited number of smaller rooms to suit a family or couple, all with share bathroom facilities.

OFFSITE—For those who wish to stay offsite, we are asking that you **book this accommodation yourself, and do it soon.** Below are some options of caravan parks that you may like to check out, with an idea of prices. You could also try Ray White Real Estate who deal in holiday villas, units & houses (08) 9937 1700 or www.kalbarriacommodation.com.au

Anchorage Caravan Park – next to PCYC— 9937 1181

Cabins (no ensuite) - \$70 per night for two people, \$80pn with linen.

Murchison Caravan Park – Main Street—9937 1005

Park homes with ensuite & 2 bedrooms (1 double bed, 2 bunks) - \$105 per night for 4 people + \$12 pn for each additional person. Cabins (no ensuite) \$85 pn for two people. Deluxe Cabins, with queens size bed and 2 single beds \$136 pn including linen.

Tudor – Big 4—1800 681 077

Ensuite cabins (1 room with double bed made up and 2 bunks (need linen) separated by curtain) \$100/per night for 2 people + \$10 extra for adult, \$8 extra for child pn.

Brick homes with ensuite & 2 bedrooms - \$140 per night (comfortably sleeps 4 adults).—Mention you're from the Cathedral for a 10% discount.
